

Life-Saving **Components of Blood**

Medical Condition	Average Number of Units Needed Per Patient
Thalassaemia	3 to 4 red cell units per month
Coronary Artery Bypass Graft (CABG)	2 to 3 red cell units
Blood Cancer Treatment	1 to 2 red cell units and 1 to 2 adult
& Stem Cell Transplant	dose of platelet units per week
Road Traffic Accident	8 red cell units
Gastrointestinal Bleed	6 red cell units
Liver Transplant	10 red cell units
