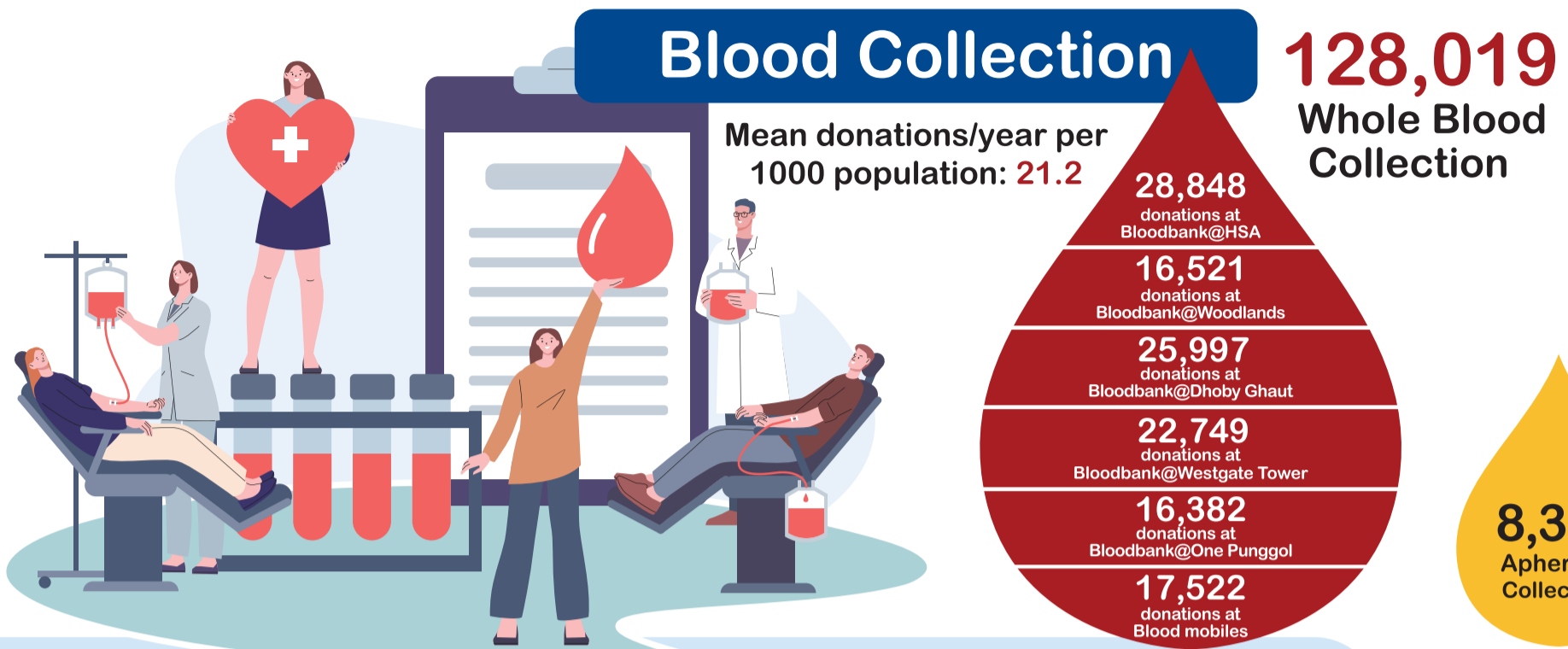


The Big Blood Picture 2024

60% Male Donors

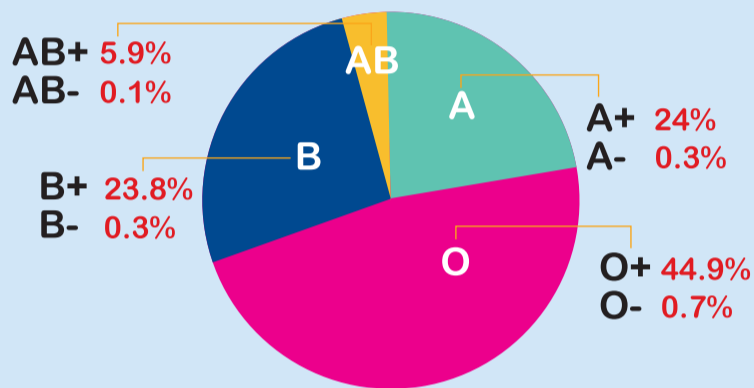

Estimated Blood Usage Rate for 2025



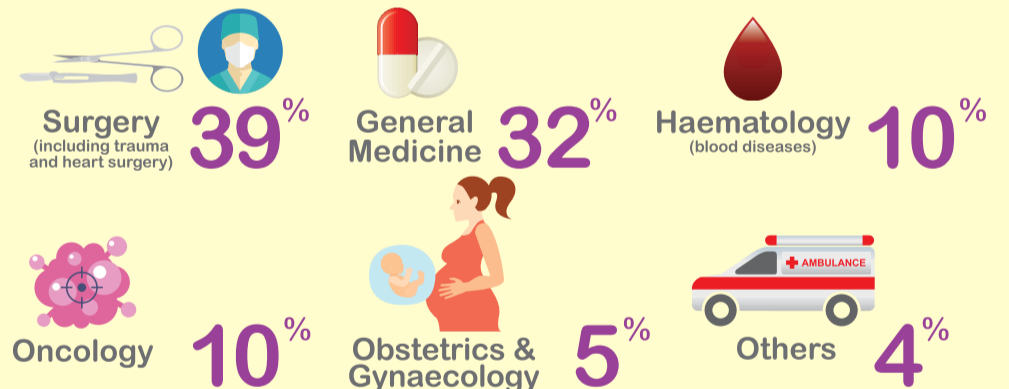
Blood Processing and Testing

415,374 blood components processed

1,449,529 laboratory tests conducted on blood components

All donated blood collected is sent for processing and testing at the HSA's laboratories before it is transfused to patients.

Annual Estimate of Singapore's Blood Usage



Life-Saving Components of Blood

Medical Condition	Average Number of Units Needed Per Patient
Thalassaemia	3 to 4 red cell units per month
Coronary Artery Bypass Graft (CABG)	2 to 3 red cell units
Blood Cancer Treatment & Stem Cell Transplant	1 to 2 red cell units and 1 to 2 adult dose of platelet units per week
Road Traffic Accident	8 red cell units
Gastrointestinal Bleed	6 red cell units
Liver Transplant	10 red cell units
