## Laboratories with HLA-B\*15:02 and HLA-B\*58:01 genotyping test services



## HLA-B\*15:02 test:

• This is a standard of care test for new patients of Asian ancestry prior to starting treatment with carbamazepine (CBZ). This test helps to identify patients who may be at risk of developing Stevens-Johnson Syndrome (SJS) or toxic epidermal necrolysis (TEN) due to the genetic (HLA-B\*15:02) susceptibility to CBZ sensitivity.<sup>1</sup>

## HLA-B\*58:01 test:

• This test may be offered to at-risk patients due to the association between HLA-B\*58:01 allele and allopurinol-induced severe cutaneous adverse reaction (SCAR). While HLA-B\*58:01 allele is a known risk factor, reactions may still develop without the allele as there are non-genetic factors that increase the risk.<sup>2</sup>
